BAM Construction will be working in partnership with hub West Scotland and NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde to deliver this project.

This is our third quarterly newsletter which aims to provide our neighbours with updates as we progress with the construction of the new Parkhead Hub.

Construction Update

Our construction works are well underway with the structural steel frame now completed. The roofing works and SFS metal external wall build-up has also recently commenced. The floor slabs are also being poured just now.



Social Value Update

Since the last period we have progressed with a number of our social value projects including:

- Our Health & Wellbeing Programme is ongoing and we have held several mental health and alcohol awareness talks to support our workforce on site
- Our Employment Pathway Programme launched. We have partnered with the Wise Group to undertake training with a group of local candidates who face barriers to employment. The candidates are working through construction training, towards their CSCS and undertaking work experience placements on site
- Our second education programme launched with training provider TIGERS. BAM, hub West Scotland and the project consultants are supporting 12 young people from Whitehill & St Andrew's Schools through their Construction Foundation Apprenticeship qualification
- The NHS Capital Planning team, BAM and Hub West Scotland are working closely with Glasgow Caledonian University to deliver guest lectures, course support and site visits
- BAM are supporting a local Foundation Apprentice and two Graduate Apprentices on site
- Hub West Scotland, BAM, project consultants and subcontractors came together to support the Mental Health Network Greater Glasgow and revamp the organisation's premises as part of hub West Scotland's Helping Hands Initiative with over £130k being donated
