Sharon Wearing	Jan-22	<p>The Ministerial Strategic Group reported in February 2019 on their review of integration. This review concluded that the arrangements for hospital budgets and set aside requirements must be fully implemented by July 2019 to enable IA's to plan the use of these budgets during 2019/20. The Scottish Government has given a commitment to work with IA's, Health Boards and Local Authorities to ensure the legislation and statutory guidance is put into practice. It is part of the action plan for the MSG report.</p> <p>Glasgow City IJB is currently leading on the development of a commissioning plan to support the strategic planning for set aside services. The draft commissioning plan was approved at the IJB in March 2020 and has been subject to consultation. An updated draft final plan was submitted to the IJB in September 2021. This plan will help to determine the services which require to be commissioned under set aside arrangements and how this will shift over time. It will be used to support strategic planning of these services by both the health board and the IJB.</p>	Open
