1. Purpose

- 1.1. To seek approval of appointment to Glasgow City Integration Joint Board and provide an update on a number of membership vacancies.

2. Background

- 2.1 The process to seek nominations for the vacant Independent Sector representative took place in September/October 2022.
- 2.2 There continues to be a vacancy on the IJB for a Third Sector representative.
- 2.3 There continues to be a vacancy on the IJB for a Carers representative.
- 2.4 Stephen Gibson, Divisional Director Planning, Housing & Building Standards in Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability has left his role in Glasgow City Council on 21st November 2022, and subsequently his membership of Glasgow City IJB as a non-voting professional member has ended.

3. Updates to the IJB for Approval

- 3.1 The process to seek nominations for an Independent Sector representative was undertaken in September/October 2022. The nominations were reviewed by Susanne Millar, Chief Officer, on the basis of their supporting statements. Subsequently, David Reilly is nominated as a non-voting member of the IJB representing the Independent Sector, for a three-year term, and requires IJB approval.

4. Updates to the IJB for Noting

- 4.1 The Third Sector Health and Social Care Network is the appropriate forum from which to seek Third Sector representation on the IJB. The network is due to meet on 12th December where it is hoped that a representative will be identified. Ian Bruce continues to represent the Third Sector in a substitute role on Glasgow City IJB.
- 4.2 HSCP Officers are in discussion with the Carers Reference Group in the city and an options paper will be presented to a future meeting on how best to represent carers at the IJB.
