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### STRATEGIC PLAN CONSULTATION UPDATE

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<b>Provider Organisations:</b>	Provider organisations will be given the opportunity to respond to the consultation on the draft Strategic Plan.
<b>Equalities:</b>	A number of actions have been and will be taken to increase diversity of respondents to consultation and ensure a good level of engagement with equalities groups.
<b>Financial:</b>	A level of financial resource has been made available to support this activity, and spend will be managed through the Strategic Plan Working Group chaired by the Head of Business Development.
<b>Legal:</b>	The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Scotland) Act 2014 and associated Regulations prescribe a minimum level of consultation that must be taken in development of IJB Strategic Plan. The proposed approach outlined in this paper satisfies and goes significantly beyond that minimum.
<b>Economic Impact:</b>	None
<b>Sustainability:</b>	None
<b>Sustainable Procurement and Article 19:</b>	None
<b>Risk Implications:</b>	Failure to adequately consult on the Strategic Plan presents a reputational risk to the IJB and to HSCP.

## 1. Purpose

- 1.1 To update committee on consultation being carried on the draft IJB Strategic Plan 2019-22

## 2. Background

- 2.1 The Glasgow City Integration Joint Board ('the IJB') is required by statute to produce a Strategic Plan for health and social care within Glasgow City. Strategic Plans cover a three-year period, with the current plan running until March 2019. A revised plan is therefore required covering the period 2019-22.

- 2.2 Essential to the development of the Strategic Plan ('the Plan') is a robust Consultation, Engagement and Communications Strategy, to ensure that all stakeholders are aware of work being undertaken to develop the Plan and have an opportunity to contribute towards its development.
- 2.3 The Public Engagement Committee agreed the draft Consultation, Engagement and Communications Strategy for the Strategic Plan in May 2018 – paper available at <https://glasgowcity.hscp.scot/sites/default/files/publications/ITEM%20No%2006%20-%20Strategic%20Plan%20%E2%80%93%20Consultation%2C%20Communications%20and%20Engagement%20Strategy.pdf>

### 3. Strategic Plan Consultation

- 3.1 The draft Strategic Plan was published for consultation from 24 October 2018. Consultation documents are available at <https://glasgowcity.hscp.scot/strategic-plan-consultation>
- 3.2 Consultation has been publicised by mailings to various distribution lists held by Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership (with recipients asked to share with their own networks), messages on HSCP, Council and Health Board web pages and social media platforms, at meetings and events held locally and other opportunities where these have presented themselves.
- 3.3 As previously noted, a number of consultation events have been held, or are scheduled in support of the draft Strategic Plan
