GLASGOW CITY INTEGRATION JOINT BOARD BUDGET MONITORING FOR MONTH 6 AND PERIOD 7 2019/20

Purpose of Report:	This report outlines the financial position of the Glasgow City Integration Joint Board as at 30 th September 2019 (Health) and 27 th September 2019 (Council), and highlights any areas of budget pressure and actions to mitigate these pressures.			
Background/Engagement:	The financial position of the Glasgow City Integration Joint Board is monitored on an ongoing basis throughout the financial year and reported to each meeting of the Board.

1. Purpose

- 1.1 This monitoring statement provides a summary of the financial performance of the Glasgow City Integration Joint Board for the period 1 April 2019 to 30th September 2019 (Health), and to 27th September 2019 (Council).
- 1.2 It is based on information contained in the respective financial systems and includes accruals and adjustments in line with its financial policies.

2. Summary Position

- 2.1. Net expenditure is £4.645m lower than budget to date. Gross expenditure is £3.845m (0.01%) underspent, and income is over-recovered by £0.800m (1.36%).
- 2.2 Appendix 1 shows the current budget variance by both care group and subjective analysis.

3. Budget Changes

3.1 Throughout the financial year, adjustments are made to the original approved budget as a result of additional funding allocations and service developments. During Month 6/Period 7 the net expenditure budget has increased by £0.738m. The changes to the gross expenditure and income budgets are analysed in the table below.

4. Transformation Programme

4.1 The overall savings target for 2019/20 is £18.255m. At this stage of the year it is anticipated that actual savings realised will be £17.062m representing 93% of the target. The shortfall is related to Shifting the Balance of Care for Adult Services. The forecast savings position will be updated as the Maximising Independence Programme moves forward. This programme represents the future for service delivery but will take time to implement, impacting on savings delivery in the short term.

- 4.2 Of the unachieved savings of £3.809 from 2018/19, £0.500m are still to be realised. Currently £3.309m is forecast to be achieved, 87% of the total savings target. The balance outstanding relates to Learning Disability Purchased Services. This is being looked at as part of the Maximising Independence Programme. Progress against all savings targets will continue to be reviewed during the year through the Integration Transformation Programme Board.
- 4.3 The savings realised are reflected in the overall financial position reported in this monitoring statement.

5. Reasons for Major Budget Variances

5.1 Children and Families

- 5.1.1 Net expenditure is underspent by £1.998m.
- 5.1.2 Employee costs is underspent by £0.859m mainly due to a combination of vacancies in the provided residential units and Localities, and new investment funding for which plans are now underway. This figure includes an overspend in Community Nursing of £0.579m due to Health Visiting overspending as a result of the regrading from band 6 to band 7.
- 5.1.3 Work continues in support of the Transformation Programme within Children and Families and has secured a further reduction in Residential Schools placement numbers of 4 since 1st April 2019. At period 7 the underspend is £0.400m, with a full year projected underspend of £0.742m.
- 5.1.4 Provided Fostering is underspent by £0.302m with placement numbers totalling 595, a reduction of 39 since 1 April 2019.
- 5.1.5 Supported Living is underspent by £0.284m mainly in respect of new investment funding for which planning is underway.
- 5.1.6 Public Agencies is underspent by £0.160m following a review of the Multi Treatment Foster Care programme.

5.2 Adult Services

- 5.2.1 Net expenditure is underspent by £0.781m.
- 5.2.2 Employee costs are underspent by £2.8m throughout all services due to periods of vacancies, turnover and difficulties recruiting to posts. This underspend also reflects the early delivery of savings for 2020/21 following the redesign of Glasgow Alcohol and Drug Recovery Service. Recruitment continues to be progressed for vacant posts in all services.
- 5.2.3 Learning Disability are overspent by £1.536m. This is attributed to Purchased Services, including SDS which is £1.556m overspent at period 7. This overspend related to unachieved savings and the impact of transitional drift from Children and Families, and onwards to Older People. High cost services continue to be managed via the Management and Allocation of Community Resource Options Group (MACRO)

- 5.2.4 Expenditure of £0.555m in relation to Housing First has been incurred and is reflected in the overspend above. Scottish Government funding is being pursued.
- 5.2.5 Adult Services has recently assessed the needs of 3 adults who are fit for discharge in a Tier 4 Hospital setting and have identified shared accommodation options with the combined cost of £375,637 per annum recurringly. In accordance with Glasgow City Council standing orders, these were considered and approved at Glasgow City Council's Contract and Property Committee on 29th August 2019. These packages of care have been recommended following consideration of a range of service option to meet these individual care needs. The IJB is asked to approve these commitments on a recurring basis funded from within existing budgets.

5.3 Older People and Physical Disability

- 5.3.1 Net expenditure is underspent by £1.515m.
- 5.3.2 Employee costs within Older People are underspent by £0.190m. This is as a result of staff turnover of £0.498m in a number of services including Community Health Services. This is offset by an overspend of £0.231m as a result of the costs of agency and overtime to cover sickness absence and additional staffing costs relating to end of life care within the Residential Service.
- 5.3.3 The Carer's Service budget is underspent by £0.579m as a result of part year implementation of the investment agreed by the IJB in June. Budgets are also underspending following the closure of Birdston (£0.342m).
- 5.3.4 The financial position for Older People now reflects the £4.7m deficit funding proposed from the Council and the IJB.

5.4 Resources

- 5.4.1 Net expenditure is underspent by £0.118m.
- 5.4.2 Staffing costs underspend is the main driver as a result of vacancies throughout the year in areas including Admin/Business Support, Senior Management and Planning.

5.5 Primary Care

- 5.5.1 Primary Care is showing an underspend position of £0.233m.
- 5.5.2 GP Prescribing budgets for 19/20 have now been adjusted to reflect the full year forecast expenditure position, as advised by our Prescribing lead colleagues and based on the latest available data. This includes confirmation of the average share of the discount clawback from 18/19 due to NHS Scotland. This was not known at budget time and equates to £2.4m for Glasgow City. This is subject to annual review and negotiation and as such cannot be treated as recurring.
- 5.5.3 The removal of the risk share arrangements in 2018/19 in relation to Prescribing requires the IJB to deal with over and underspends. Detailed monitoring arrangements continue to be in place for this budget area to assist with the management of risk in relation to global prices and the potential impact of Brexit. Current forecasts show an underspend of £4.5m which is currently being held in

contingency to manage the risk which exists as a result of Brexit. This will continue to be closely monitored and will be the subject of future updates to the IJB.

5.5.4 This will continue to be closely monitored and will be the subject of future updates to the IJB.

6. Outturn

- A probable outturn has been completed and is projecting a year end underspend of £9.4m. The main sources of this underspend are outlined below:-
 - £10.3m across a range of services due to vacancies as a result of staff turnover and delays in recruitment. This is a continuing theme from last financial year and staff recruitment continues to represent a challenge both in terms of timescales to recruit and the availability of the skills mix required within the workforce market. A number of actions continue to be progressed including streamlining recruitment processes, aligning recruitment timescales with the availability of newly qualified professionals, development of targeted recruitment and training strategies to develop existing and new staff to meet the skills requirements of our services.
 - £3.0m early delivery of our transformation programme, securing delivery of savings proposed for 2020-21.
 - £1.7m funding for Carers investment which was agreed by the IJB in June but will underspend this year as a result of part year implementation.
 - £0.9m funding from Scottish Government for Rapid Rehousing which will not be fully utilised this financial year and will require to be carried forward to 2020-21 to enable the IJB to deliver on its commitment in relation to this strategy.
- The areas identified above represent an underspend of £15.9m, some of which have been off-set by the overspends being experienced within Adult Services (£2.8m) as a result of the demand being experienced across the system.
- As part of the 2019-20 budget it was assumed that earmarked reserves would be used to assist a phased implementation of the savings in Homelessness (£1.3m of which £0.8m required) and to manage the demand in Older People Services for care home placements (£2.9m). In light of the outturn reported above, it is proposed that this is managed within the overall underspend and not transferred from earmarked reserves.
- 6.4 This leaves a net outturn of £9.4m. It is proposed that £0.9m is carried forward and earmarked as a reserve to cover the liabilities in relation to the Rapid Rehousing. This leaves a balance of £8.5m.
- On 26 June 2019, the IJB approved the Maximising Independence Programme, which represents a significant reform to how services will be delivered in the future. Significant investment will be required to support this programme and an opportunity exists to earmark the remaining underspend of £8.5m to pump prime the investment required. This is the subject of a separate report to the IJB and this report recommends that £8.5m is earmarked to support the development of this programme over the next two financial years.

The overall position will continue to be kept under review and any significant changes reported as we move closer to the year end.

7. Medium Term Financial Outlook

- 7.1 On 27 March 2019, the IJB approved its first medium term financial outlook which identified a funding gap of £100m over three years.
- 7.2 The IJB's current financial performance will be considered when assessing the financial outlook for the next three years. As part of this an assessment of areas which are either under or over spending will be required to be undertaken to establish the impact that it will have over the medium term. For example although section 6 identifies £15.9m of underspends, all of these are non-recurring as a result of vacancies for which we have plans to fill, or are as a result of plans which will be fully implemented in 2020-21 and therefore will no longer underspend or are part of our plans for future year savings and will be removed from the budget.
- 7.3 An updated medium term financial outlook is currently being developed for presentation to the IJB in March 2020.

8. Action

8.1 The Interim Chief Officer, along with the Health and Social Care Partnership Senior Management Team, continues to manage and review the budget across all areas of the Partnership.

9. Conclusion

- 9.1 Net expenditure is £4.645m lower than budget to date.
- 9.2 A probable outturn has been completed and is projecting a year end underspend of £9.4m. It is proposed that £0.9m is carried forward and earmarked as a reserve to cover the liabilities in relation to the Rapid Rehousing. It is recommended that the balance of £8.5m is earmarked to support the investment required in the Maximising Independence Programme over the next two financial years.
- 9.3 A number of savings initiatives through the transformation programme have yet to achieve the required level of savings. These initiatives are being critically reviewed and closely monitored by the IJB's Integration Transformation Board.
- 9.4 In line with the approved Reserves Policy, any net underspend which may occur within 2019/20 will be transferred to reserves at the end of the financial year in order to provide future security against unexpected cost pressures and aid financial stability
- 9.5 A number of potential risks are highlighted throughout this monitoring report which will require to be mitigated going forward and these will be considered as part of our revenue budget plans for 2020/21.

10. Recommendations

- 10.1 The Integration Joint Board is asked to:
 - a) note the contents of this report;
 - b) approve the earmarking of the projected outturn of £9.4m as outlined in section 6 of this report;
 - c) approve the recurring funding for the packages of care outlined at section 5.2.5; and
 - d) note the summary of current Directions (Appendix 2).
