1. Purpose

- 1.1 To provide an update on changes to the membership of Glasgow City Integration Joint Board (GCIJB) and seek approval of an appointment to the IJB Finance, Audit and Scrutiny Committee and the role of Vice Chair. This report also provides an update on a Scottish Statutory Instrument to extend IJB voting rights to service user, unpaid carer and third sector representatives.

2. Background

- 2.1 The Glasgow City Council Meeting of 24th February 2026 approved a change to the membership of Glasgow City IJB. This change has resulted in a vacancy on the IJB Finance, Audit and Scrutiny Committee for a Council Voting Member and Vice Chair.

3. IJB Appointments for Noting

- 3.1 The Glasgow City Council Meeting on 24th February 2026 confirmed that Councillor Davena Rankin will join Glasgow City IJB as a Council voting member, replacing Bailie Ann Jenkins.

4. IJB Committee Appointments for Approval

- 4.1 As per Regulations and the IJBs own Standing Orders, appointments to Committees of the IJB are a matter for the IJB itself.
- 4.2 The IJB is asked to approve the appointment of Councillor Davena Rankin as a Council Voting Member on the IJB Finance, Audit and Scrutiny Committee, replacing Bailie Ann Jenkins.
- 4.3 The IJB is asked to approve the appointment of Councillor Jon Molyneux as Vice Chair of the IJB Finance, Audit and Scrutiny Committee. The Chair and Vice Chair alternate every two years.

5. The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Integration Joint Boards) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2025

- 5.1. In the membership update report brought to the IJB at its meeting on [21st January 2026](#), members were informed that the Scottish Government had laid before parliament a Statutory Instrument to amend the Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Scotland) Act 2014 to extend IJB voting rights to service user, unpaid carer and third sector representatives.
- 5.2. The Scottish Parliament's Health, Social Care and Sport Committee have concluded their scrutiny of the impact of the legislation, with no MSP submitting a motion to annul, therefore the Instrument will come into effect by September 2026.
- 5.3. The Scottish Government have established a working group to consider the practical implementation of the extension of voting rights, including recruitment, governance, codes of conduct and training and development.
- 5.4. Further updates will be brought to the IJB once the required changes to existing arrangements are understood.
