1. Purpose

1.1 To provide an update on a number of changes to the membership of the Glasgow City IJB. To seek approval of removal of an Acute Services representative from the Membership.

2. Background

2.1 At Glasgow City Council's City Administration Committee (CAC) on 11th April 2024 it was approved that Cllr Audrey Dempsey would be replaced on the Glasgow City IJB by Cllr Ann Jenkins. This appointment also creates a vacancy on the IJB Public Engagement Committee.

3. IJB Appointments for Noting

- 3.1 There is a change to the Third Sector representative on the IJB where Fi Grimmond will replace Angela Bonomy as a non-voting member, this was previously approved by the IJB in May 2023 as a planned replacement.
- 3.2 Ian Bruce, Chief Executive of GCVS, will continue as the substitute for the Third Sector representative.

4. IJB and Committee Updates for Approval

- 4.1 As per the IJBs Standing Orders, appointments to Committees of the IJB are a matter for the IJB itself. The IJB Public Engagement Committee has a vacancy for a Council voting member following the departure of Cllr Audrey Dempsey. A replacement will be sought in due course.
- 4.2 There has been an ongoing vacancy for an Acute Services Representative on the IJB since the role was filled by the Chief Operating Officer, Jonathan Best. Since he left the role the IJB has not been able to fill this vacancy. This role is not a requirement for IJB membership as set out in The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Integration Joint Boards) (Scotland) Order 2014 but was selected as one of the professional advisor roles by Glasgow City IJB when membership was agreed by the IJB in 2016.
