Susanne Millar / Kelda Gaffney		<p>A letter from the Lord Advocate, Dorothy Bain KC, to GCHSCP on 11th September 2023 indicated her agreement to publish a statement of prosecution policy to the effect that it would not be in the public interest to prosecute users of a Safer Drug Consumption Facility (SDCF). The IJB subsequently approved in September 2023 the implementation of a SDCF and development of a full engagement plan.</p> <p>A SDCF Implementation Board has been tasked with overseeing implementation and has remitted a Communication and Engagement Group to develop an Engagement Strategy and Plan. The Engagement Strategy is due to be considered by the Implementation Board on 13th November 2023 and will be available to Members thereafter. A presentation outlining the approach to engagement, based on the full draft Strategy, is tabled for discussion and input at Public Engagement Committee on 15th November 2023. Feedback will be used to finalise the Engagement Strategy and a more detailed Engagement Plan.</p> <p>Update reports will be provided to the Committee during the planning and implementation phase.</p>	Open
