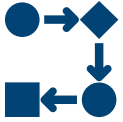

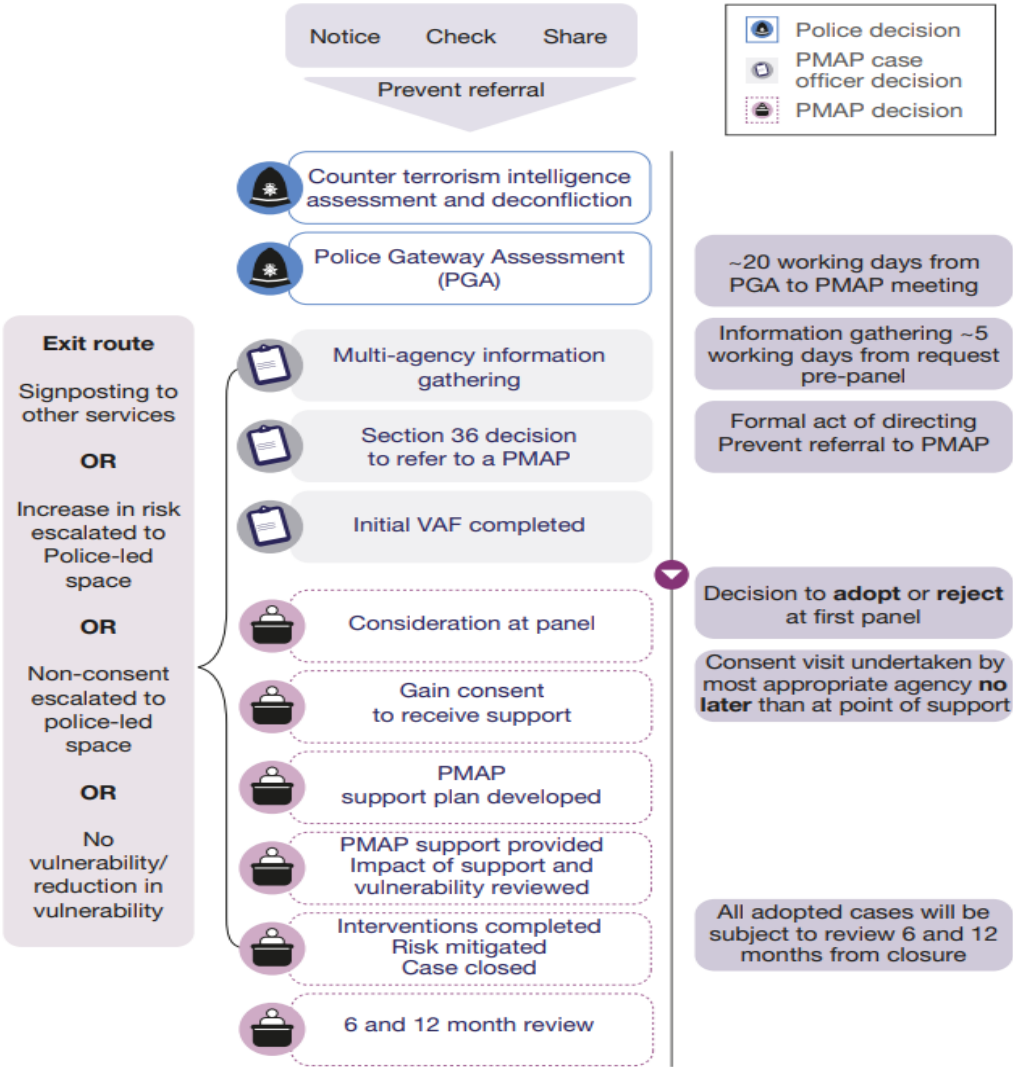
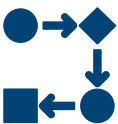

WHAT IS PREVENT?



- PREVENT is about safeguarding people and communities from the threat of terrorism.
- PREVENT is one pillar of CONTEST, the UK Government's counter-terrorism strategy.
- The Counter Terrorism and Security Act legally requires Glasgow City Council to have a Prevent Multi-Agency Panel (PMAP) in place with the sole purpose of providing support to those individuals who are identified as being susceptible to being drawn into terrorism.
- Individuals adopted into PMAP will have a multi-agency safeguarding plan put in place to ensure they get the necessary support.
- PMAP is a consent based approach

PROCESS & CASE STUDY EXAMPLE



Case Study Example

- A 16 year old was receiving treatment from CAMHS service for their mental health
- CAMHS worker identified concerns regarding individual displaying concerning behaviours indicating a developing extreme right-wing ideology.
- The individual had shaved his head and begun to dress in a neo-Nazi style 'skinhead' aesthetic
- Adopted into PMAP
- Intervention Provider (IP) commissioned to work with individual. Education, social work and CAMHS all provided support.
- Case closed following 7 IP sessions
- Risk mitigated
- No further issues raised at 6 and 12 month review
