Nursing Service available for those with a need for palliative and end-of-life care, They also have the Helper Service, which is managed by Marie Curie providing fully trained and checked Helper Volunteers to support any terminally ill adult and their family in the comfort of their own home Their Support Line is also open six days a week, helping with both practical information and emotional support, and should it be required a Marie Curie Nurse to talk to, the helpline is open to anyone who is living with a terminal illness or those who are caring for someone that is terminally ill.
