### **Construction Update**

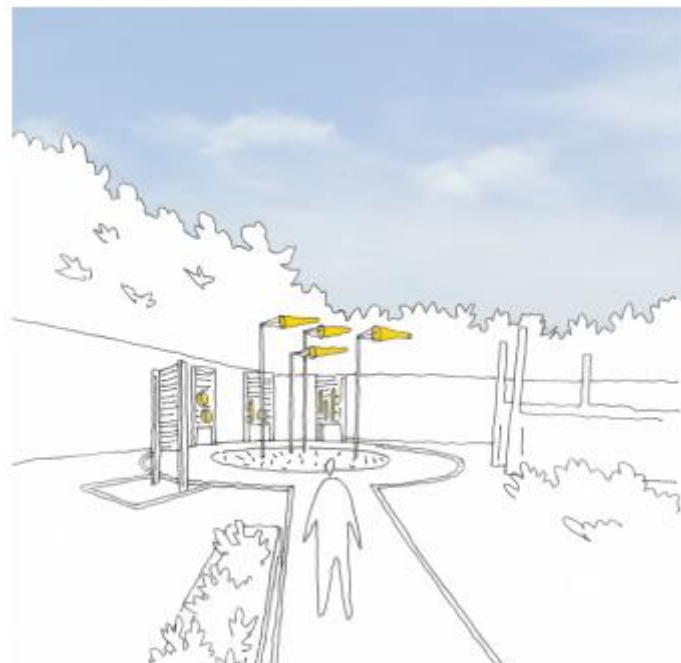
Our construction works are well underway with the external walls now taking shape and the internal fit out works progressing. Windows and curtain walling units are being installed and we are well underway to being completely wind and water tight.



## Social Value Update

Since the last period we have progressed with a number of our social value projects including:

- Our Health & Wellbeing Programme is ongoing and we have held several mental health and alcohol awareness talks to support our workforce on site. The NHS have also just recently delivered talks on site regarding managing finance.
- Our second education programme launched with training provider TIGERS. BAM, hub West Scotland and the project consultants are supporting 12 young people from Whitehill & St Andrew's Schools through their Construction Foundation Apprenticeship qualification. Members of the BAM management team at Parkhead Health Centre have helped to deliver various talks/courses with the tigers to help them on their path of completing there studies.
- Through the community benefits programme Parkhead Health Centre have partnered with Ashton ASN school to construct a sensory garden. This will be completed with the aid of the Tigers and pupils from Ashton ASN school. All materials have been kindly donated and will be installed by the subcontractors who are currently working at Parkhead. These include Dalcon, SCS and Lesterose. Construction will commence on 15.05.23.
