Someone who looks after a partner, relative or friend who cannot manage without their help because of illness, frailty or disability. They may or may not live together


A Young Carer is:

A person under the age of 18 who provides or who intends to provide care for an adult or child needing care, except where the child needs care solely due to its age















The Impact of Covid-19 on Carers

81% of unpaid carers are currently providing more care than before lockdown.

78% of carers reported that the needs of the person they care for have increased recently.

64% of carers have not been able to take a break in the last 6 months.

58% of carers have seen their physical health impacted by caring through the pandemic, while 64% said their mental health had worsened



Referral is Triaged by SW Carers Team

P1

Carer or cared for at extreme high risk of the Caring role breaking down. It may be that the Carer has become unwell! This work is undertaken by Social Work Services

P2

Carer or cared for at risk of caring role breaking down unless supports put in place to ease the situation.


This work is undertaken by Social Work Services

P3

Carer is managing but recognises that support may be beneficial. Support provided: information & advice, emotional support, money matters, short breaks, training & 'having a voice'. Undertaken by the local carers centres.
