New Parkhead Hub



The new state of the art Parkhead Hub will open in a phased approach from **Monday 27 January 2025**, with all services expected to be operating from the Hub in February 2025.

The Hub is located on the site of the former Parkhead Hospital, Anvil Centre and Parkhead Health Centre at Salamanca Street at 1251 Duke St, Parkhead, Glasgow, G31 5NZ.

Services based at the Hub

The new Hub integrates health, social care and community facilities, including a cafe and the relocated Parkhead Library.

Forge Medical Practice, Drs McKenzie and Burns and Meadowpark Surgery GP practices will be operating from the Hub from Monday 3 February 2025.

Other services include health and social care services for children, adults and older people, and specialist support through addictions, justice, homelessness and sexual health services (Sandyford East), Community Pharmacy and Public Dental Services, as well as a range of health improvement initiatives. The Hub will also include a number of clinics which are being relocated from Glasgow Royal Infirmary.

The HSCP Learning Centre (a citywide resource for staff) is also based at the Hub.

Drop off and collection points – There are two patient drop off points outside the main entrance next to the public cycle racks. Staff cycle storage is internal to the building and is accessed near to the staff entrance/exit.

Car parking - Limited car parking is currently available on the site. A new public and separate staff car park will be built on the Parkhead Health Centre site once it is demolished and will be available later in 2025.

On street parking is available in the area and Parkhead Forge Shopping Centre are offering a designated zone for HSCP staff.
