

Introduction of the Red Bag to support Care Home Transfers to and from Acute Services

This initiative is currently being introduced to all care homes in Partnerships across the NHSGG&C

Board area

It is a simple process that brings together the following in one place:

- **Information** on the resident to support decision making and to communicate details of their care
- Medication

Although limited medication will be needed by the resident to attend acute services, the bag provides a compartment for this and any discharge medication required



- Glasses / dentures / hearing aids
- Toiletries
- Nightwear
- Day time clothing to ensure that the resident has day time clothing to wear if appropriate during their stay and for when they are discharged (including shoes)





Care homes, Scottish Ambulance Service and acute services are supporting this process as it provides many benefits including:

- Improves access to information on residents admission and discharge
- Supports approach to medication for admission and discharge
- Reduces unnecessary time for all stakeholders less phone calls and follow up required
- Preventing admission where appropriate to enable earlier assessment and treatment
- Reduces length of stay

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
