You may be aware that Glasgow City is opening Scotland's first Safer Drug Consumption Facility (SDCF).

SDCFs are supervised healthcare settings where people can inject drugs, obtained elsewhere in the presence of trained health and social care staff in clean, hygienic environments.

The service aims to reduce the negative impact that injecting outdoors has on local residents, communities and businesses and reduce the harms associated with injecting drugs and support people to access appropriate help.

If you have any questions or concerns, we welcome you to meet with project leads and Police Scotland at an informal drop in. We hope this will be an opportunity for community members to hear about the plans and have questions answered one to one.
